As you can see, our year to date expenses exceed our year to date income We are fortunate that we have an Investment Account that began as the proceeds from an estate that was donated to the church. The downside is that any expenses not covered by donations and rent income from the Preschool and other users of the facilities will be charged against the Investment Account. If you need a tax deduction when you file 2022 taxes, please keep Sierra Vista in mind. We are a non-profit organization and donations to Sierra Vista are deductible for those who file itemized returns.

If you have not returned your response to our annual Stewardship campaign, it's not too late. Pledges can be sent in any time, however, it helps when we can get an idea of what to expect for the coming year. Our pledges are volunteer submittals and although we track progress, we do not send out dun notices.
