If you are like most people, the last two weeks of the year are a flurry of activity. One of those activities is giving. Not just Christmas gifts, but last minute giving to charities before the year ends. These include mission outreaches, or your college. Many people give last minute to their church (time to get caught up on that pledge). In Arizona people give to tax deductible charities that count toward their State Taxes. Those can include schools or organizations like Crossroads Mission or Arizona Baptist Children's Services (which are mission partners of our church).

2 May we thy bounties thus as stewards true receive and gladly, as thou blessest us, to thee our first fruits give

ALL THAT WE HAVE IS THINE ALONE, A TRUST, O LORD, FROM THEE!

That is the definition of Stewardship. Recognizing that all we have is from the Lord and then using all that we have to glorify God. I like the way that How reminds us that as we RECEIVE God's blessings we GIVE in response to God's blessing.

This Christmas as you make your last minute donations, remember, you are sharing God's blessing with others.
